

Local Rules

The Etiquette of the Game and the Care of the Course is Expected of all Players.

1. U.S.G.A. Rules of Golf govern all play.
2. Out of Bounds is defined by white stakes, fences and roads. A ball which crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.
3. The Embedded Ball Rule is in effect “through the green”.
4. All sprinkler heads and yardage markers are measured to the center of the green.
5. Signals for suspending and resuming play:
Suspension - one long blast;
Resumption - three short blasts.
6. For all play at Nevillewood, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only.
7. U.S.G.A. Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1 are modified as follows:
When a player’s ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent or equipment. The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced.
